## NW-SCC CCAMPIS

The Child Care Access Means Parents in School (CCAMPIS) program is a federal grant funded by the U. S. Department of Education to support student-parents. This program supports the participation of low-income student-parents in post-secondary education through the provision of campus-based child care services.

CCAMPIS provides NW-SCC student-parents with:

- Financial Assistance with child care fees
- Increased opportunities to access parenting and/or educational resources and participation in center activities.

Student-parent applications are considered for child care assistance through CCAMPIS funding on the basis of eligibility status, financial income, need, resources, and family contribution levels. Please review the Participation Guidelines and Program Eligibility criteria carefully before completing the Application Packet and returning it to the address listed below.

### PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

1. Students must meet eligibility criteria and complete the Application following these Guidelines, attaching the appropriate proof of eligibility documentations with application and essay.
2. Participant must be eligible for a Pell grant award and calculated EFC and be in good standing with NW-SCC.
3. Participant must be enrolled or intend to enroll at least part-time (min. 6 hours) in a declared degree-seeking program at NW-SCC. Less than 6 credit hours per semester is not eligible.
4. CCAMPIS will pay 75% for 6-11 credit hours per semester, or 85% for 12+ credit hours per semester.
5. Participants cannot receive any other child care subsidies.
6. Childcare stipends will be administered as direct reimbursements to the high quality childcare provider of the student's choosing if the child is under 2 ½ years-old or not yet mastered toilet training, or if there is not space available in the campus-based child development center. The CCAMPIS Program is contingent upon funding and will provide assistance while funding is available. **CCAMPIS is not a cost-free program.** Participants are responsible for the childcare balance remaining after stipends are applied to costs. Charges vary from one service provider to another.
7. Participants will be required to comply with the rules and regulations of the childcare facility selected.
8. Participants will be required to participate in evaluation activities.
9. The NW-SCC CCAMPIS Program is not responsible for services and/or activities provided by any other childcare facilities than its own.
10. Participants will be evaluated at the end of each semester to verify the participants continue to meet all items listed in the Participant Agreement.
