Only permanent full-time employees are eligible to apply. Applicants must meet the minimum qualifications and must submit a Letter of Interest and resume to be considered.

- QUALIFICATIONS:**
- Minimum of a short-term certificate in electrical, **required**.
 - Associate degree in electrical, preferred.
 - Minimum of two years of documented maintenance work experience in electrical, **required**.
- ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**
- Performs grounds maintenance duties, including landscaping, lawn and plant care, leaf removal and tree trimming.
 - Operates equipment such as fork-lift, lawn equipment, automatic floor scrubbers and floor buffers.
 - Records and maintains accurate records of time, invoices, and materials.
 - Observes safety regulations, uniform code, and all college policies.
 - Makes recommendations to the Maintenance Supervisor regarding budget, safety, planning, etc., as it relates to specific responsibilities.
 - Assist in maintaining plumbing fixtures, water leaks and roof repair.
 - Be knowledgeable in conduit bending, electrical fixture installation.
 - Be knowledgeable in utilizing various test equipment, volt-ohm meter, amp meter.
 - Be knowledgeable in various electrical panel's and electrical disconnects.
 - Be knowledgeable in various high voltage and low voltage equipment. Including transformers, electrical motors, starters, contactors.
 - Be knowledgeable in electrical diagrams and diagnosing electrical problems in various equipment.
 - Be knowledgeable in commercial wiring, wiring electrical circuits, installing new electrical equipment.
 - Assists crafts and trades workers as assigned; assists in delivery of supplies, mail and moving furniture for College events.
 - Assists in special projects of maintenance and cleaning during school breaks.
 - Attend all meetings as required.
 - Assist in college event set-ups.
 - Serve on committees as assigned.
 - Attend all job-related training programs.

- Perform all other duties as assigned by the maintenance supervisor or assistant supervisor or his or her designee.
