2023-2024 Dual Enrollment Program**

COST OF ENROLLMENT

Students registering for Dual Enrollment for Dual Credit courses are responsible for the cost of tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials and supplies as required in the syllabus of each course at NW-SCC, unless covered by alternative funding sources.

Students who fail to pay tuition and fees by the payment deadline, are not considered enrolled and may be dropped from course rolls. The appropriate LEA and/or other secondary educational entity will be notified.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES AT NORTHWEST-SHOALS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Dual Enrollment Scholarship Workforce Grant. High school students in the 10th, 11th, or 12th grade can receive a scholarship for up to two classes per semester. The counselor at the high school should submit a proposal including the estimated number of students who are planning to register for academic or CTE courses to request funds on a yearly basis.

The DE Scholarship Workforce Grant for dual students covers up to two courses per semester, fall and spring. During summer semester the DE Scholarship covers up to four CTE courses or one academic course.

Student must be enrolled in a CTE Career Pathway to be eligible. English must be included in the approved Career Technical program of study.

Students must meet all applicable pre-requisites prior to enrolling in courses. Developmental Courses (those numbered below 100) are not covered by the scholarship.

Note:

- Students taking CTE courses must meet with their instructor prior to choosing a Career Pathway. Students must remain in their Career Pathway after that.
- Scholarships can cover up to two classes per student, per semester (fall and spring semesters) during the high school academic school year.
- Students may take up to four CTE classes during the summer term or one academic course
- Students who fail a course, will not be allowed to continue in the DE Workforce Scholarship Program.

Development Courses	Those numbered below 100, are not covered by the scholarship
