



## Radiography Program Hospital Observation Hours Documentation Form

Applicants to the Radiography program may submit this hospital observation form for additional ranking points. Only Students with a minimum of **8 hours observation** will be awarded these points.

Observation forms are accepted from hospitals, not clinics, that have an ARRT registered technologist that performs general radiography (not just CT, MRI, Ultrasound, etc.). The form must be signed by an R.T.(ARRT).

All area hospitals are aware of this program requirement for students. I suggest you contact a radiology supervisor, introduce yourself, and explain that you are an applicant for the radiography program and would like to schedule 8 hours of observation. All 8 hours **do not** have to be on the same day. Some facilities will require HIPAA training before you are allowed to observe.

Professional attire (scrubs may be acceptable) is required for this observation. Students dressed inappropriately will not be allow to complete the observation.

On completion of the observation have the technologist sign the included form and turn it in with your application. Copies are acceptable. Contact the radiography faculty if you have questions. Thanks for your interest in the radiograph program.
